(FOOTPATH No. 17, TOTNES)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

The order came into force on Thursday, 1st August 2024 and would have expired on Saturday, 1st February 2025.

By direction of the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the order shall continue in force until Friday, 1st August 2025 or until works have been completed, whichever is sooner.

No persons shall proceed on the section of the affected path except for access to land or premises on or adjacent to that length of path.

Public rights of way affected:

FOOTPATH No. 17, TOTNES where it crosses the Mill Leat via a footbridge.

The alternative route is via the Access For All Path linking the riverside area with National Cycle Network Route No. 2, and National Cycle Network Route No. 2, and vice versa.

The closure is necessary because the footbridge has been assessed as unsafe.
